

# SPIRIT OF THE GAMES VALUES- ASSEMBLY PACK

**Aim:** To promote and raise awareness of the School Games and its values .

**Duration:** 10 minutes.

**Overview:** Over the last few years we have seen big changes in competitive school sport at primary school level with increased participation, a wider offer of sports and more inclusive opportunities. The priority for us now locally is around delivering impact and 'an educationally powerful competition experience'.

We want to make sure that all of our experiences provide a rich and positive learning experience for all young people so we will be continuing to promote the 'Spirit of the Games' values at our events and would like to encourage schools to get involved by ensuring their children know what these values mean and why they are important in sport, school and everyday life. We have put together a Spirit of the Games Assembly presentation which schools can use in an assembly or with individual classes to introduce the 7 values and to get children thinking about what they mean and how we can learn through sporting experiences. ## **Spirit of the Games Values are:**

Honesty, Determination, Passion, Respect, Self-Belief, Teamwork and Eco Friendly.

These values are not only important in sport but also the wider school context and everyday life. You may want to consider how you can promote them or use them in your schools, for example:

- Display the Spirit of the Games Values around school- Making them a focus on your PE Noticeboard.
- Do they link to your whole school values.
- Can they be used as rewards for PE/ School Sport- Sport star(s) of the week.
- Using them as a reward system in school to support schools achieve their broader whole school objectives.
- Can school sport/competition and these values support an ethos of aspiration and personal best in your school.
- Can you use these values to promote inclusive opportunities for all young people.
- Playing to all pupils the NEW SSP Spirit of the Games Values assemblies.
- Ensure parents are aware of the Spirit of the Games Values via newsletters and website.
- Awarded during Intra-school events/ activities.
- Highlight to staff and pupils that attend festivals/ events the spirit of the games value so that they can hand out stickers and reward certificates at the SSP School Games Inter-school events or festivals.

**Deliverer:** To pause the video and ask the question. How can we demonstrate honesty at home? Once discussed watch how we think you can demonstrate Honesty at home.

**Deliverer:** Ask the children if they can remember what honesty means? Ask the question. How are you going to demonstrate honesty at school or at home?
